- ◆ The Assembly instructions are divided into seven blocks: A (head), B (body), C (legs), D (tail coat), E (arm), F (silk hat), and G (message board). Follow the instructions for each block to assemble your teddy bear.

- ◆ ★ marks a basic assembly technique that remains the same regardless of the part. Instructions are printed only for the first instance.


### <Caution>

- ✘ Keep scissors and glue away from small children.
- ✘ Be careful not to cut your fingers when using scissors.

## **A** Assemble the head

Use pattern: Page2 / Page3.


- ① Cut out A1 by cutting along the lines.
  - ★ Cut along the line marked




- ② Make a mountain fold on A1.
  - ★ Trace along the mountain fold line with a pencil, scoring it to make it easier to fold.




- ③ The parts will be easier to assemble if curled.
  - ★ Using the photo as a guide, apply pressure with the palm of your hand, gradually curling the paper in the direction of the arrow.




- ④ Add a slight curl to A1 when attaching it.
  - ★ Attach the triangular glue tabs so that the front side becomes convex.
  - ★ Using the photo as a guide, attach in the direction of the arrow.




⑤ Cut out A2 and A3, curl them and glue the triangular glue tabs, attaching each to A1.




⑥ Assemble A4 and attach it to A5.



⑦ Assemble A6 and A7 in the same way, and attach the ears to the head.



⑧ Assemble A8, and attach to the head. Assemble A9.




**\*Note:** The completed A9 will be attached in the last step.


## **B** Assemble the body

Use pattern: Page4 / Page5.


① Attach B1 and B2 together.




② Attach B4 and B5, then attach B3 and B6.




③ Attach B1, B2 to B4, B5.



④ Assemble B7.




⑤ Assemble B4, B5 and B7.



⑥ Attach B8, B9 to B4.



⑦ Attach B10, B11 and B12 and attach it to B6.




\*Note: The completed head will be fitted in a later step.


## C Assemble the legs

Use pattern: Page6 / Page7.


① Assemble C2 through C8.




② Attach C1 through C8 together.




③ Assemble C9 through C16 in the same way.



④ Attach the legs to the body that you made earlier.




⑤ Fit the head to the body, and attach A9 to complete the legs.




## D Assemble the tail coat

Use pattern: Page8.

① Attach D1 and D2 together.




② Assemble D3 and attach it to D4.



③ Assemble D5 and D6 in the same way, and attach D3 and D5 together.







④ Assemble D1, D2, D3 and D5, to complete the tail coat.




## E Assemble the arm

Use pattern: Page9 / Page10.

① Assemble E1 through E9.




② Attach E1 through E8 together.



③ Assemble E10 through E18 in the same way.



④ Fit both arms to the completed tail coat.




⑤ Put on the tail coat, to complete the arms section.




## F Assemble the silk hat

Use pattern: Page11.

① Assemble F2 and attach it to F1.



② Attach F3 and F4 and attach it to F2. Put the hat on Teddy's head and that completes the top hat assembly.



## G Assemble the message board


Use pattern: Page12.

① Choose a message for G1 and stick it on.



\* If writing your own message, please write it on G1. This explanation refers to the attached messages.

② Assemble G2, G3, G4 and G5 and attach it to G1. Next, stick on G6.



③ Attach G8, G9, G10 to G7 and attach it to G6.



④ Assemble G11 and attach it to G1 to complete.
